Article 2

The event is open to athletes men Elite and Under 23 category. The event is included on the UCI Europe Tour calendar as a class 2.1 event. In confirmity with the UCI rules, points for the UCI ranking Europe Tour are awarded from 1st to 25th place (points per stage in table below).

Participations

Article 3

As per article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to the following teams: UCI World Teams(50% max), UCI Profesional Continental Teams, UCI Continental Teams and National Teams. As per article 2.2.003 of the UCI regulations, teams must be formed of minimum 5 (five) and maximum 7 (seven) riders.

Race Headquarters

The team Managers meeting organized in accordance with article 1.2.087 of the UCI regulations, in the presente of the Commissaire Panel, is schedules on Wednesday, 17.April 2019 at the 17:00h in the race headquarters.

Riders confirm their start and colect number from 15:00 to 19:00h, at 27.april Friday in Race headquarters.

Radio Tour

Article 5

Radio tour will be at the race (for all teams, suports and sport department). Radio chanel reserved only for the race.

Neutral Technical Suport

Article 6

Neutral service support will provide by 3 vehicle.

Finishing deadline

Article 7

For each stage there is a finish deadline corresponding to the winner's time plus 5%. Any case of force major or exceptional situation will be settled by the Commissaire Committee after consultation with the race management.

Bonuses

Article 8

Time bonuses, applied only to the finish line $10^{\prime\prime},6^{\prime\prime},4^{\prime\prime}$, are awarded for all stages according to article 2.6.019 of the UCI regulations. They not concern intermediate sprints and mountain sprints.

Awarded as follows:

- *Intermediasprint general clasficiation
- *Mountainsprint general calsification
- *Young rider general clasficiation
- *Sponsors sprint

General Individual classification

Article 9

The general individual time classification is established by adding together the times recorded for each stage, taking penalties into consideration, in accordance with article 2.6.014. of the UCI regulations. In the event of a tie, the places achieved for each stage are added up and, as a last result, the place obtained in the final stage is counted. The leader of the general individual time classification will wear a yellow jersey the following race day. Total amount of prize money for the general individual time classification is by UCI regulations for UCI 2.1 events.

Intermedia sprint classification Mountain sprint classification

Article 10

A points classification is established by adding together the points obtained in each stage as well as the intermediate sprints according to article 2.6.017 of the UCI regulations. Points for the all intermediate sprints in each stage will be awarded as follows: 3,2 and 1 point (s) to the first 3 riders.

The leader of the points classification will wear a green jersey and the mountain leaders will wear polka jersey, the following race day. In the event of a tie in the general individual points classification, the following criteria shall be applied in the following order until there is a true ranking.

- 1°) number of stage wins;
- 2°) number of wins in intermediate sprints;
- 3°) general individual time classification. To be entitled to final general classification prize money, competitors have to complete the entire race within the official time limit. Prize money awarded for theintermedia sprints classification is as follows 1st in intermedia sprint and mountain sprint general clasification will be 300 euro for the first in general classification for both category.

Young rider classification

Article 11

Only riders born after 1st January 1997 may take part in he young rider classification. Prizes money awarded for this category will be 300 euro for the first in general classficiation

Antidoping control

Article 12

Antidoping tests will be carried out under the UCI regulations.

Protocol Ceremony

Article 13

After each stage, the following riders must present themselves at the protocol ceremony not late then 15 minutes, because LIVE TV coverage.

- *First 3 riders in stage
- *Leaders in general indvivdual clasification, intermedia sprints general classiciation, mountain sprint general classification, young riders leader.
- *After last stage all leaders, first 3 riders in stage and first 3 riders in general clasification.

Penalties

Article 14

Penalties are in accordance with the UCI regulations.




